Emergency Measures Program Bylaw

Community Government of Wekweètì

BYLAW NO. 2015-02

A BYLAW of the Council of the Tłicho Community Government of Wekweètì in the Northwest Territories, to provide for a community emergency management program.

WHEREAS the Council of the Community Government of Wekweeti is responsible for the direction and control of its emergency response and is required, under the *Civil Emergency Measures Act, R.S.N.W.T.* 1988,c. C-9 as amended, to: appoint an Emergency Measures Committee, establish and maintain an Emergency Measures Agency; and appoint a Coordinator of the Emergency Measures Agency and establish the duties of the coordinator.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Community Government of Wekweeti, in regular session duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

EMERGENCY RESPONSE COMMITTEE

- 1. A committee for the Tłlcho Community Government of Wekweeth is hereby established to manage and coordinate emergency operations, the membership of which includes:
 - a. Chief

d. Alexis Arrowmaker School Principal

b. Council

; e. Lay Dispenser

c. SAO

f. Community Town Foreman

EMERGENCY MEASURES AGENCY

- 2. An Emergency Measures Agency for the Community Government of Wekweètì is hereby established to aid in the preparation and implementation of the emergency plan, the membership of which includes:
 - a. Chief and Council;
 - b. SAO;
 - c. Tlicho Government.

The members of the Emergency Measures Agency shall assume such powers, and take such action as outlined in the Emergency Measures Plan.

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EMERGENCY MEASURES AGENCY COORDINATOR

- 3. The Senior Administrative Officer shall be appointed as the Emergency Measures Agency Coordinator and his/her duties shall include:
 - a. Development, preparation and coordination of emergency plans and programs.
 - b. Enter into agreements with and make payments to organizations for the provision of services in the development or implementation of emergency plans or programs.

EMERGENCY PLAN REVIEW

4. The TłĮchQ Community Government of Wekweètì Council shall test and review the Emergency Plan and related plans and programs at a minimum of every two years.

REPEAL

5. By law # _____ is repealed.

COMING INTO EFFECT

6. This By-Law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading.
